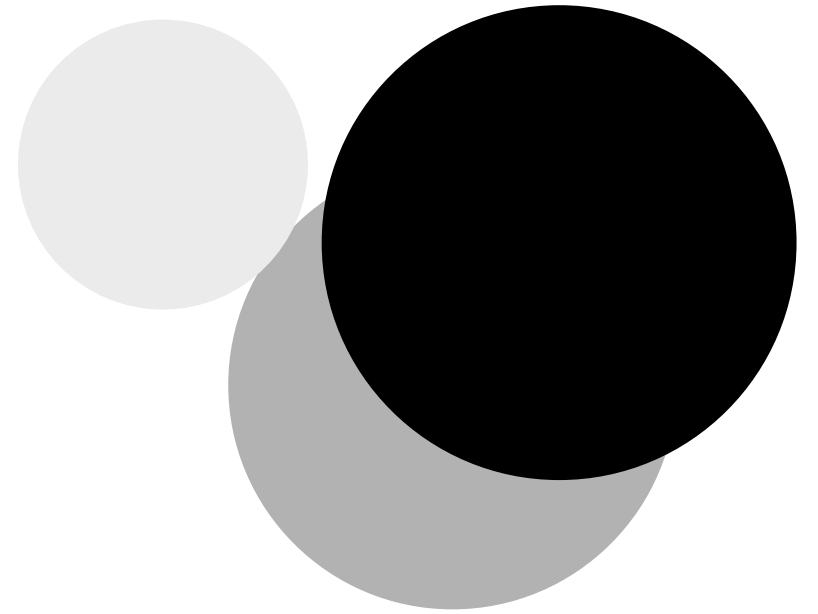

# What to do when you're sick and miss a class

**If you've had a serious accident, or a serious family crisis:**

Leave a message with your name, student number, details of what happened and your phone number.

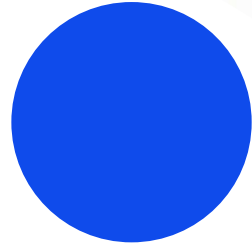

# Sexual Assault & Harassment



- **Consent** means freely agreeing to engage in any form of sexual or intimate activity whether it be sexual intercourse, touching or kissing. Consent is mutual agreement.
- **Consent** is mandatory. You must always get verbal, conscious permission before engaging in any sexual acts: Every time!
- **Sexual harassment** is any unwanted or unwelcome sexual behaviour, which makes a person feel offended, humiliated or intimidated.

# Sexual Assault & Harassment

- **Indecent assault** is unwanted touching of a person's body by another person. For example it can include kissing or inappropriate touching of a person's breasts, bottom or genitals.
- **Sexual assault** occurs when a person is forced, coerced or tricked into sexual acts against their will or without their consent, or if a child or young person under 18 is exposed to sexual activities. Sexual assault is a crime and can happen to anyone in our community.

When you receive your written response you will also be provided with contact details of external bodies. If you are dissatisfied with your response, you may contact the external bodies for further advice.

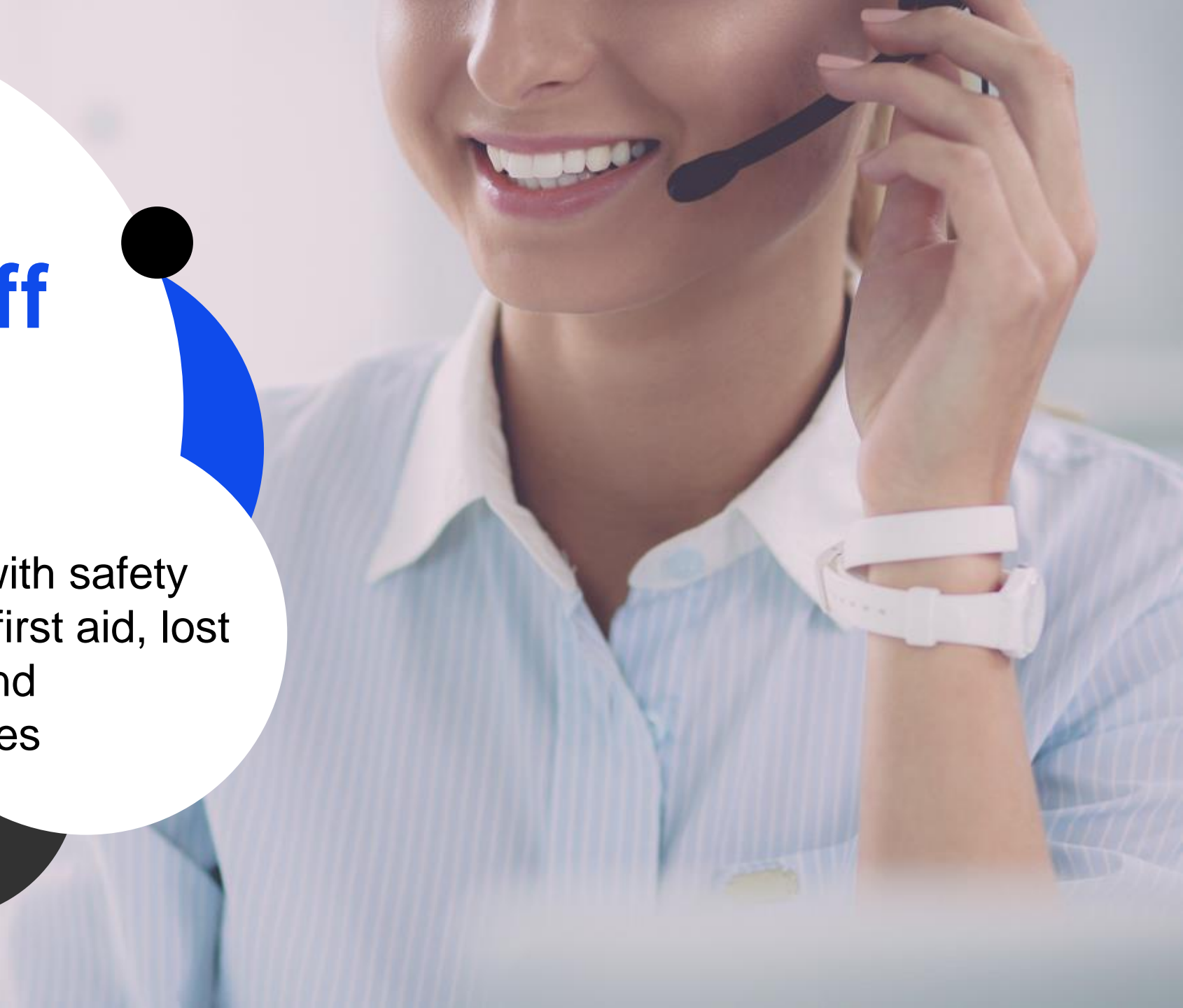




# Security staff in the Blue Building
