
To succeed, you must attend every class – remote or on campus.

Sexual Assault & Harassment

 Consent means freely agreeing to engage in any form of sexual or intimate activity whether it be sexual intercourse, touching or kissing. Consent is mutual agreement.

 Consent is mandatory. You must always get verbal, conscious permission before engaging in any sexual acts: Every time!

 Sexual harassment is any unwanted or unwelcome sexual behaviour, which makes a person feel offended, humiliated or intimidated.



 Indecent assault is unwanted touching of a person's body by another person. For example it can include kissing or inappropriate touching of a person's breasts, bottom or genitals.

 Sexual assault occurs when a person is forced, coerced or tricked into sexual acts against their will or without their consent, or if a child or young person under 18 is exposed to sexual activities. Sexual assault is a crime and can happen to anyone in our community.
