UTS: DESIGN, ARCHITECTURE & BUILDING (DAB)

UTS's Faculty of Design, Architecture and Building (DAB) consists of three schools that span the full range of architectural, design, construction, property and planning disciplines. Students learn in facilities that include computer labs, textiles workshops and photomedia studios. In the Motion Capture Lab, animation students learn to use the same world-class system adopted by animation companies around the world.

DAB has an extensive network of over 150 partnerships with key industry and government organisations, including Google and Westpac. These connections provide the unique opportunity to work on real-world projects, with many degrees involving industry placements. Industry partners also regularly sponsor or attend end-of-year exhibitions and shows.
