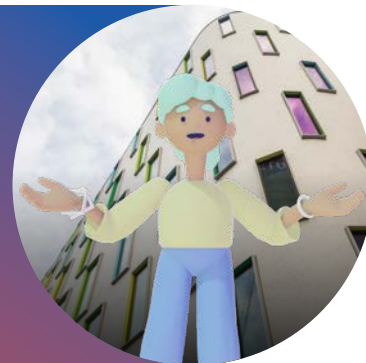

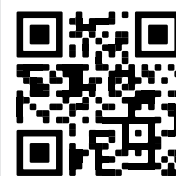

## Academic English

Our Academic English (AE) programs provide you with the English language and academic literacy skills required for entry to an English speaking university.

**Duration:** 200 hours / 10 weeks per level

- **AEL3** Entry into UTS Foundation Studies and extended diplomas.
- **AEL4** Entry into UTS College standard graduate certificates and standard and accelerated diplomas.
- **AEL5** Entry into UTS College accelerated graduate certificates and most UTS undergraduate and postgraduate degrees.

The UTS Cambridge Accelerator combines globally recognised Cambridge International AS and A Levels with the option of four first year university (diploma) subjects, Academic English (AE4 and AE5) and the Duke of Edinburgh's International Award program. Students access the world-class UTS campus, facilities and services, while being provided specialised under-18s welfare and wellbeing support by UTS College.

- **First year** Four AS Level subjects and two diploma subjects.
- **Second year** Three A Level subjects and two diploma subjects.
