



| UTS College Pre-Master's Programs | IELTS 6.0 with 6.0 in writing | Associate Degree (AQF 6) |




Pre-Masters overview


- Guaranteed pathway with 24 credit points towards selected Masters' degrees at UTS Faculties of Business, Engineering and IT, Arts and Social Sciences and Transdisciplinary Innovation
- Program accredited as a Graduate Certificate, a recognised Australian qualification (AQF level 8).
- Designed to help develop language and academic skills by offering Academic English subjects in those areas (English for Postgraduate Study 1 & 2) and further embedding those skills into the adapted UTS subjects.
