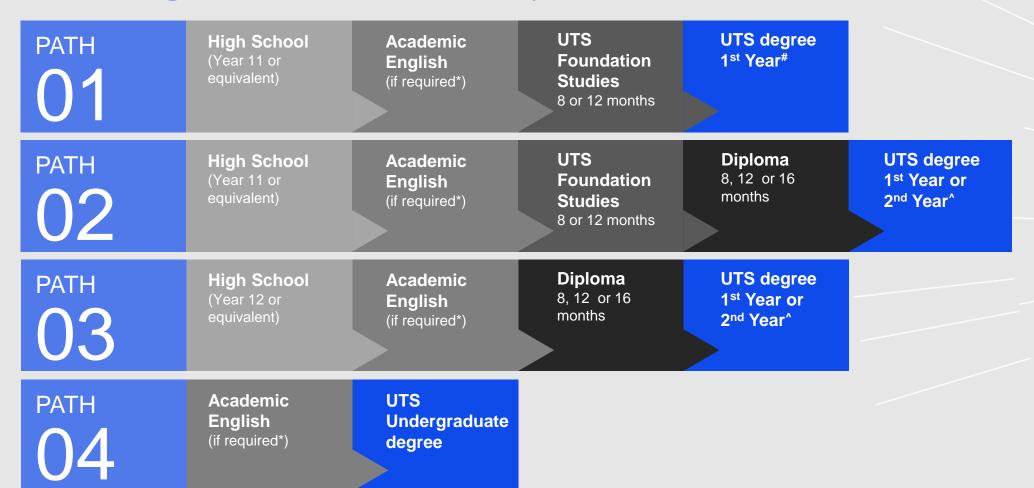

Domestic vs Onshore Students

What's the same?

Entry requirements and program fees are the same for domestic and international students.

What's different?

- Domestic students (citizens only) can use Fee-Help
- If choosing Fee-Help, there are certain steps that they can only do themselves when accepting their offer (e-caf submission)
- Articulating to UTS is also different, there is a certain GPA to achieve for Domestic students (accessible on website)



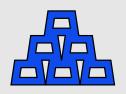

• **Diploma of communication** in 2023 to UTS Bachelor Animation in 2024.

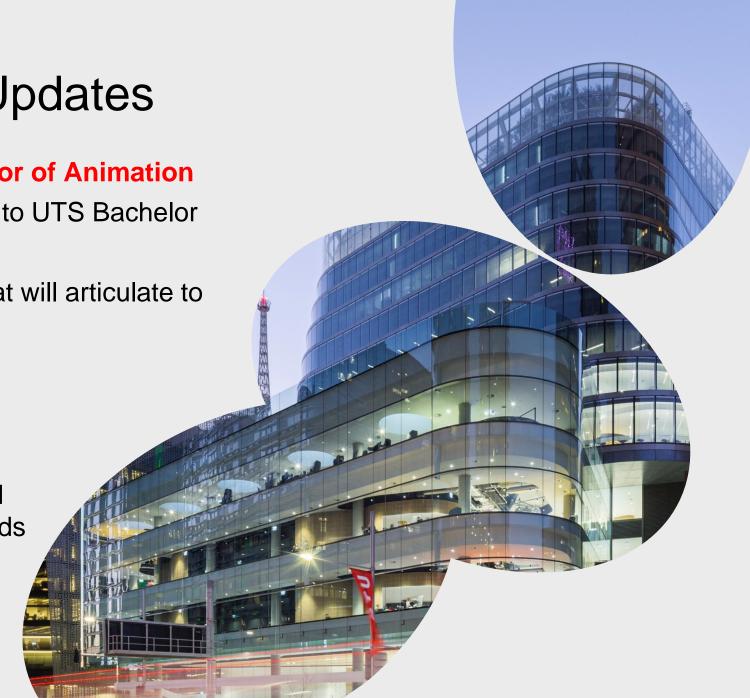
 New diploma of Animation in 2024 that will articulate to UTS Bachelor of Animation in 2025.

Diploma of Science

 2 maximum fails has been removed.
 Students must pass all subjects of the Diploma of Science for entry into a UTS Bachelor of Science.

Diploma of Business

Students now have the option to articulate to a <u>Bachelor of Property Economics</u> (C10310). Students will receive 24 credit points towards this degree.

- Students will receive an offer automatically



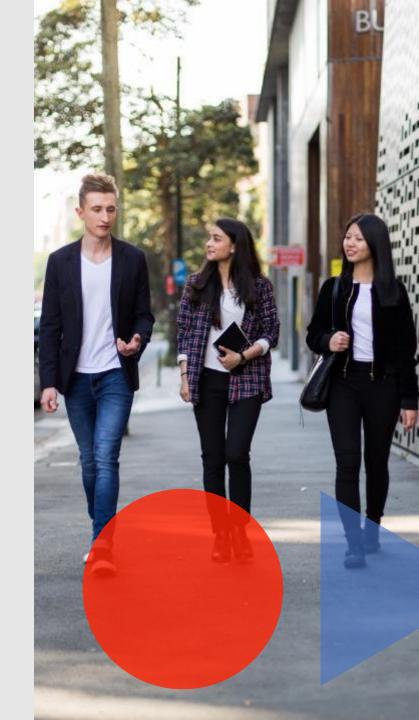
