		UTS Foundation Studies		After the course has started	Students will be issued 100% of the tuition fees paid for the semester if the student provides evidence to UTS Insearch of a visa refusal before the results are published for that semester and confirm they do not wish to receive any record of subjects undertaken in that semester. Note that refunds are not available for any fees paid for earlier semesters because results have already been published.
Withdrawing	International	Diploma UTS Foundation Studies	Withdraw from an academic course	Before the start of the course	Students are eligible for a refund including the international student processing fee (ISPF) and UTS CoE fee, provided a travel ban is still in place at the start of the semester They can also defer to the next semester without financial or academic penalty.
				After the course has started	Students cannot withdraw and obtain a refund but they can defer to the next semester without academic penalty (no fails). No additional fees to be paid in the following semester. Students must have an attendance of 80% or higher in their first semester.

				After the start of the term	They are eligible for a full refund of the remaining fees for the unused terms.
Fails in the first term/ semester	International	English UTS Foundation Studies Diploma	New student studying remotely for the first time, failing a subject (English or academic)	After the start of the term or semester in 2020	Students can repeat the failed subject with no fee payable and no fails on record providing they have managed to maintain attendance of 80% or better.

No additional fees to be paid in the following term. Students must have an attendance of 80% or higher in their first term / block.
