Intake dates & duration	<p>A two-year course with one intake per year in January. Students undertake AS Levels in year one and A Levels in year two. For the first cohort:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>AS Levels commence in January 2026.</li><li>A Levels commence in January 2027.</li><li>The first cohort completes their course in December 2027.</li></ul>

Students may also choose to articulate with 24 credit points to a corresponding UTS College diploma.</p>
<p><b>Credit points</b></p>	<p>Four UTS College diploma subjects over two years provides 24 credit points towards a UTS College diploma related to the diploma subject stream. Students can articulate with credit to either a Diploma of Business, Diploma of Engineering or Diploma of Information Technology.</p>
