## About the scholarship

The UTS College Indigenous scholarships are available to students who identify as Aboriginal and /or Torres Strait Islander and apply to study at UTS via the **Jumbunna Admission Program**. This allows you to choose one of seven UTS College diplomas. Scholarships range from \$34,000 to \$42,500, depending on the diploma you choose.

If you qualify, you'll receive one-on-one help from tutors and have access to support services at UTS.

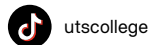
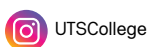
