UTS College assessment criteria

Entry into a UTS College diploma program is also assessed on an HSC subject average, based on English, plus the best three board-developed courses as follows:

- 75% for an Accelerated diploma program
- 67% for a Standard diploma program
- 63% for an Extended diploma program.

In addition, a minimum **IB** (International Baccalaureate) score of 23 or an NCEA: Level 3 with 210 credits (for New Zealand students) is acceptable for entry into a UTS College diploma program.
