Admissions

UTS College and UTS International work closely to provide a seamless admissions process for students seeking to apply for a Foundation, Diploma or Pre-Masters pathway package. Scholarships

We also provide the following scholarship opportunities for high achieving graduates:

UTS Foundation Studies Scholarship

Valued at 50% of the tuition fees this scholarship was designed to support articulating UTS College Diploma graduates. Study

In 2021 we continue to offer online study modes for students who are impacted by border restrictions while students in Australia can participate in a hybrid of study options as we reactivate the campus.

For Spring session 2021 we will continue to provide the following provisions for students who are commencing offshore and studying online for the duration of their first semester as a result of border restrictions:

- UTS will transfer the fee for any failed subject(s) to the next semester with no fail(s) recorded.
- Guarantee of a full refund or transfer of tuition fees paid if they choose to defer or withdraw prior to the <u>census date</u>
- Option to reduce study load if impacted by any remote learning difficulties.
 Students will need to lodge an application for reduced study load.
