



# Frequently Asked Questions about UTS scholarships



Question	Answer
What new UTS scholarships were introduced in July 2024, that are available to international students articulating from UTS College in 2025 and 2026?	The following new UTS pathway scholarships have been introduced by UTS for UTS College students: <a href="#">UTS Academic Excellence International Scholarship</a> <a href="#">UTS Academic Merit International Scholarship</a> <a href="#">UTS Academic Merit International Scholarship - South Asia</a>
Are these scholarships replacing any existing scholarships?	No. The existing scholarships are available until they expire.
What is the main difference between the UTS Academic Merit International Scholarship and UTS Academic Excellence International Scholarship?	The UTS Academic Merit International Scholarship is for students who meet the articulation requirements to enter UTS via UTS College academic programs. The UTS Academic Excellence International Scholarship is for students who have achieved a higher GPA in selected UTS College academic programs (UTS Foundation Studies and Pre-Master's Program).
I have a student who received an offer before the introduction of the new scholarship. Is this student still eligible?	Yes, as long as the applicant meets all criteria, they are eligible to receive the relevant scholarship.
Is a separate scholarship application required?	No, each applicant's eligibility will be assessed and the scholarship offer issued to agents in due course.

Question	Answer
<p><b>Are these scholarships available to local students?</b></p>	<p>No, students must be international students. Permanent residents of Australia, Australian citizens and New Zealand citizens are not eligible for these scholarships.</p>
<p><b>Which countries does the 'UTS Academic International Scholarship – South Asia' cover?</b></p>	<p>An applicant needs to be a citizen of Bangladesh, India, Nepal, Pakistan, or Sri Lanka.</p>
<p><b>What if a student has received a conditional offer for the UTS Academic Merit International Scholarship and subsequently completes their course with a high GPA at UTS College?</b></p>	<p>Once UTS receive final results from UTS College, UTS will automatically assess and offer the UTS Academic Excellence International Scholarship to eligible students at the point of UTS full offer issuance. If any students previously received the Academic Merit or another scholarship of lesser value, that scholarship will be rescinded and the new scholarship offered.</p>
