### Articulation requirements

7 - 13 points for three A-Level subjects required for UTS degrees. Assessment scores and equivalent points:

- A\* = 6 points
- A = 5 points
- B = 4 points
- C = 3 points
- D = 2 points
- E = 1 point

Students can articulate to any UTS undergraduate degree if they achieve the required A Level and meet English requirements. Students may also choose to articulate with 24 credit points to a corresponding UTS College diploma.

#### Credit points

Four UTS College diploma subjects over two years provides 24 credit points towards a UTS College diploma related to the diploma subject stream. Students can articulate with credit to either a Diploma of Business, Diploma of Science, Diploma of Engineering or Diploma of Information Technology.
