Genuine Student measures	India
Student age	Maximum age: 19 for UTS Foundation Studies, 21 for diploma students.
Identity	Single name applicants not accepted.
High Risk Regions	No UTS Foundation Studies or diploma applications from Punjab or Haryana.
English Entry Requirement	English ready through test approved by DHA e.g. IELTS Academic. Medium of instruction not accepted.
Gap in study	Maximum one year gap.
Married applicants	Applicants must be unmarried and not planning to marry prior to studying.
Visa refusal / Visa rejection	No previous visa refusal. No re-submission if visa refusal is received.
Finances, funds and sponsors	70k savings, 30k income. Maximum of two sponsors. Future year's plan required. Grandparents as sponsors are OK (no aunts or uncles).
Extended UTS Foundation Studies	Not offered. Standard UTS Foundation Studies only offered when a diploma pathway is not available, or when students come from an international curriculum (eg: IB or O level)
Responses to questions	Maximum 150 words per question. Maximum: three attempts.
