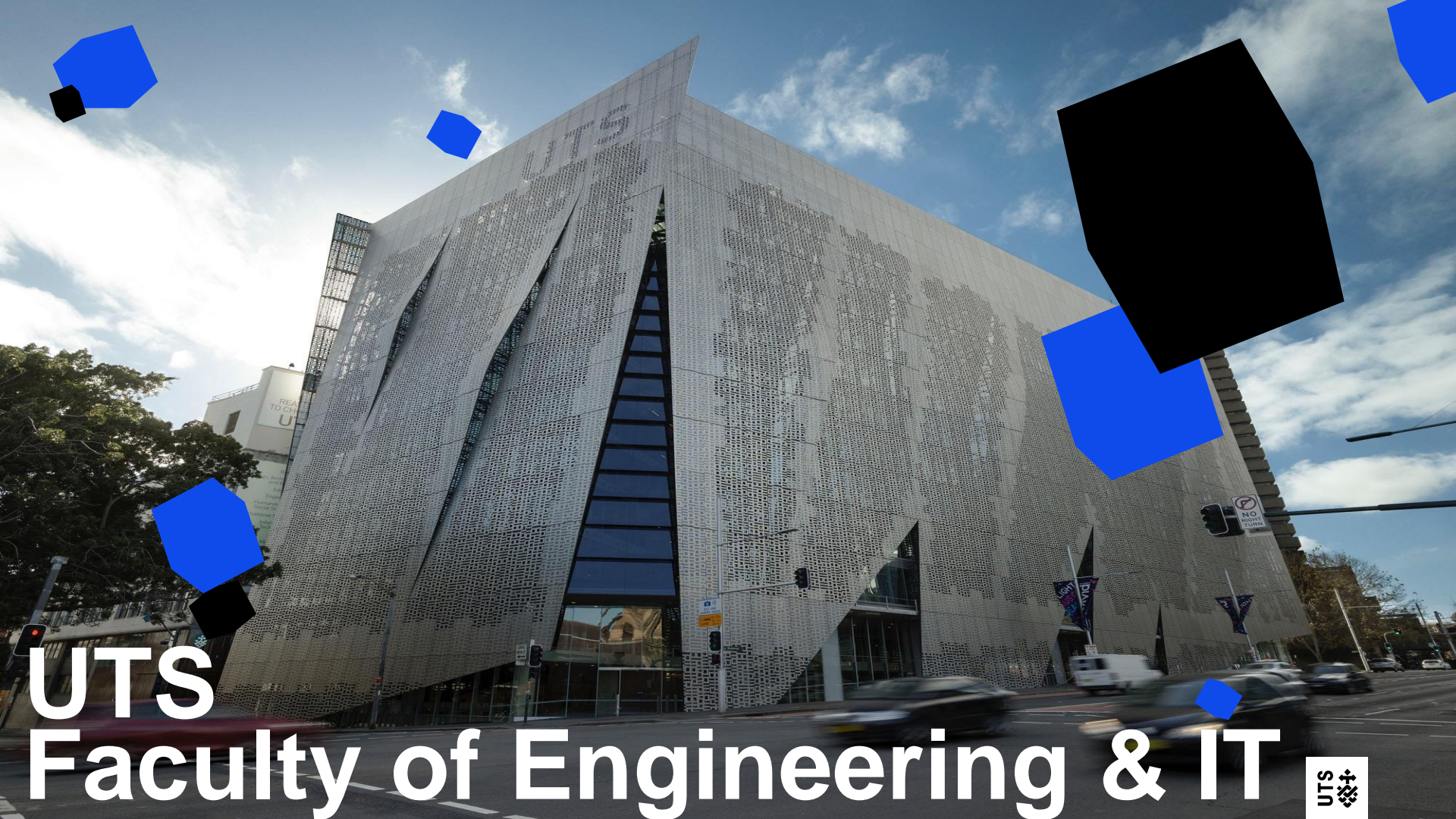

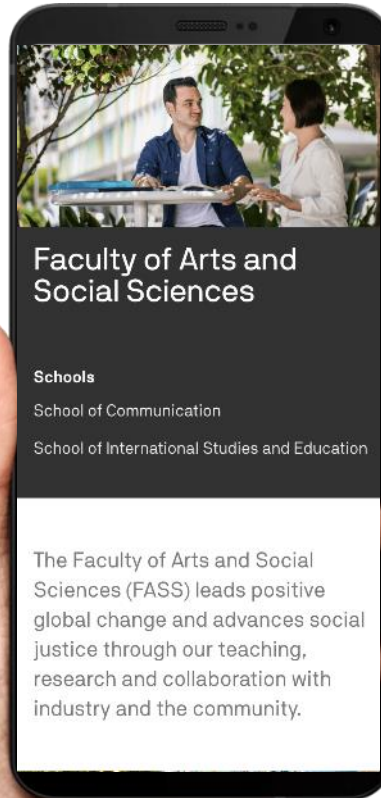

New scholarships


Who is eligible?

- Must be a citizen of Indonesia or Vietnam
- Be admitted into a UTS College Diploma program based on successful completion of the:
 - Indonesian Sekolah Menengah Umum (SMU) 3 with a competitive grade average in the academic subjects, or
 - Vietnamese Year 12 from non-UTS selected gifted/specialised schools in Vietnam and with a competitive grade average in the academic subjects
- Must be commencing studies in a UTS undergraduate degree that directly articulates from their UTS College Diploma course, and in the next available intake after completion of the candidate's Diploma

Selection Criteria

- Academic merit in the SMU 3 or Vietnamese Year 12
- Acceptance of the UTS undergraduate full offer (including payment of deposit required)

GCE A-Level Predicted Results

For 2021 intake, UTS will issue **Provisional Offers** to students that are unable to obtain certified documents with the provision that certified copies of documents must be provided prior to the end of the semester.

English Requirements

For all intakes in 2021 the following test scores will be accepted for courses requiring an overall IELTS score of 6.5 with 6.0 in writing:

IELTS indicator: 6.5 overall 6.0 writing

TOEFL iBT special home edition: 79–93 overall, writing 21

Linguaskill (using the Cambridge English Scale) : 176-184

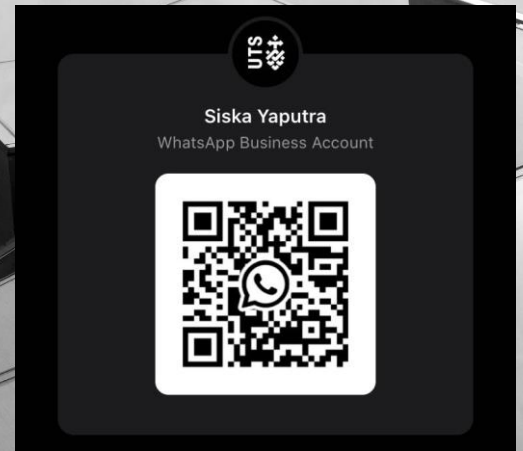
