

Terms and Conditions of the Dianne Leckie Memorial Scholarship

Number of recipients

The Dianne Leckie Memorial Scholarship (Scholarship) is awarded annually to one international student based on academic merit and personal qualities (Recipient). The top international students with the highest course Grade Point Average for the year who graduate from the Diploma of Business in any semester (one, two or three) are invited to apply for the Scholarship. A minimum of 10 international students are invited to apply each year.

Annually, two runner-up prizes (Prizes) are awarded.

Value

The Scholarship covers the balance of tuition fees for 96 credit points of study¹ in the UTS Bachelor of Business program and two years of Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) insurance fees and UTS Student Services and Amenities Fees (SSAF). The total value can be more than A\$70,000.

¹ The Scholarship covers 100% of tuition fees for 96 credit points of study in the UTS Bachelor of Business program if it is the only tuition fees scholarship held by the Recipient. For a Recipient who holds other tuition fee scholarships, only the balance of tuition fees for 96 credit points of study in the UTS Bachelor of Business will be awarded.

The Prizes are A\$1,000 each.

Eligibility criteria

- Applicants must be international students (not Australian citizens, New Zealand citizens or permanent residents of Australia)
- Applicants will be invited to apply based on their final Grade Point Average after graduating from the Insearch Limited (UTS Insearch) Diploma of Business (completing in any semester)
- Applicants must be enrolled in the UTS Bachelor of Business program

How to apply

This is an invitation-only scholarship and successful business students will be invited to apply once each year. The invitation will be sent by email to the last personal email address that the eligible student provided to UTS Insearch.

Selection criteria

Once a group has been shortlisted, an interview panel composed of UTS Insearch Education Management and Teaching Staff (Panel) will select the winning Recipient and the two runners up (Runners Up) based on several criteria, including how the applicant will use their UTS business degree to further their business career.

Payment

On production of a UTS Bachelor of Business program invoice by the Recipient, UTS Insearch will either:

- pay the tuition fee and SSAF contributions directly to the Recipient's UTS fees account each session; or
- if the Recipient also provides a receipt, reimburse the Recipient for their UTS tuition fees and SSAF contributions.

On production of an OSHC invoice and receipt by the Recipient, UTS Insearch will reimburse the Recipient for their OSHC fees.

On production of a UTS Bachelor of Business program invoice by the Runners Up, UTS Insearch will either:

- pay \$1,000 directly to the Recipient's UTS fees account; or
- if the Recipient also provides a receipt, reimburse the Runners Up \$1,000 for their UTS tuition fees.

Payments will only be made to the parties specified above.

Duration

A student holding a UTS Insearch Diploma of Business will generally complete a UTS Bachelor of Business Program in two years on a full-time study load (taking a minimum of 24 credit points per session); if the Recipient takes a reduced study load, the Scholarship will continue for an additional two semesters (together with the first two years, the 'Maximum Duration'). Where the Recipient does not complete the UTS Bachelor of Business Program within the Maximum Duration, the total value of the Scholarship will be exhausted prior to completion of the program.

The Scholarship will cover the Recipient's SSAF contributions and OSHC insurance premiums for a maximum of two years.

Other Terms and Conditions

The offer of the Scholarship is made subject to information provided by the Recipient and Runners Up being true and accurate.

The Recipient does not need to reapply for the Scholarship each year.

The Scholarship and Prizes cannot be transferred to other programs, students or institutions.

The Recipient must remain on good status at UTS. More than three subject fails will result in cancellation of the Scholarship.

The Recipient is responsible for advising the Program Manager, Business at UTS Insearch of any changes in circumstances that would make him/her ineligible for continuation of the Scholarship, e.g. changing his/her international student visa status to other visa categories, including but not limited to a permanent residency visa.

If the Recipient obtains an Australian permanent residency visa, the Scholarship will be terminated at the following time:

- If permanent residency is obtained before census date in any session, the Scholarship will be terminated, and any tuition fee Scholarship payment already made for that session will be reversed;
- If permanent residency is obtained after census date in any session, the Scholarship will be terminated with effect from the start of the following session.

For the duration of the Scholarship, the Recipient is not permitted to hold other tuition fee scholarships that will total more than 100% of the value of their tuition fees. If the Recipient does win another scholarship that partially covers their tuition fees, the Scholarship will only fund the balance of those tuition fees. The Recipient agrees to declare any other scholarship, payment or other contribution towards their Tuition Fees to the Program Manager, Business at UTS Insearch within 14 days of being granted any other contributions and provide proof of the value of the contributions.

Any changes to the Recipient's circumstances that are not addressed in these terms and conditions will be considered by the Panel on a case-by-case basis.

The Recipient will be responsible for any study costs incurred outside of UTS tuition fees, SSAF and OSHC fees.

Any Recipient found to have engaged in academic or non-academic misconduct, or to have breached the conditions set out on this webpage, will have their Scholarship terminated.

If the Scholarship is terminated due to breaching any of the Terms and Conditions set out in this document, the Recipient may be required to reimburse UTS Insearch for any Scholarship payments already made.
