

Remote Learning – UTS Updates Counsellor Training Webinar Q&A summary

Question	Answer
Can UTS Insearch students apply for this Hardship fund? or is there specific one for UTS Insearch students?	The UTS Hardship Fund is currently only available to UTS students who commenced in Autumn 2020 and were directly impacted by travel restrictions e.g. having to transit to Australia via 3rd country for 14 days of quarantine. Students need to make a claim once in Australia.
For offshore, do you require OSHC since its still online learning?	UTS does not arrange OSHC for commencing students as it is now the applicant's responsibility to provide evidence of OSHC with their visa application.
Will there be any virtual open days/sessions planned?	Yes, UTS International will host the UTS Virtual Open Day starting 25 May 2020. More information is available online here . We encourage our agents to steer potential applicants to this event to explore their options at UTS and Insearch.
Do you require year 12 final results/ATAR for 2021 assessment?	Currently there are no changes to the UAC admission process and requirements for students using their HSC results for admission to UTS. Please note that we are accepting predicted grades for IB and GCE A level students for Spring semester 2020.
